Steve is managing editor of the core organic and inorganic journals for the American Chemical Society, overseeing operations for five journals.

He earned a B.S. degree in industrial chemistry, a B.A. degree in English focused on technical writing and editing, and an M.S. degree in nuclear chemistry, all from Western Carolina University. Following a Ph.D. degree in inorganic chemistry from Wake Forest University on developing thiophene and pyrrole conducting polymers with main-group fluorinated substituents, he did postdoctoral work on fluorinated inorganic polymers at the University of Idaho.

Steve began his career in 1994 as an assistant editor at Chemical & Engineering News. Over the years his roles evolved as a writer on topics of inorganic chemistry and green chemistry and sustainability science and as an editor, rising to become senior science editor. In January 2018, after 24 years at C&EN, Steve decided to change roles to become managing editor.
